Introduction by Lukas Schmuckermair, AHW regarding the state of work and the planning for the workshop and lunchtime seminar (20.7.10) in Vienna during the WAC.

Because of the planned activities in frame of the WAC 2010 this WP started immediately after the early start of the project in January 2010. An assessment regarding the situation and needs in the participating countries was already conducted and is recently under evaluation. In March 2010 a workshop took place in Vienna to discuss possible quality assurance tools. Based on this workshop a already existing tool was chosen and discussed. The tool was shortened and adapted to cultural and cross border needs. The actual draft version of the tool, QUIET(Planning and support tool for SRHR/HIV Prevention Interventions for young People of WPF and STOP AIDS NOW!) was translated into German, Polish and Russian and sent to the partners end of May for piloting.

The oncoming activities in Vienna during WAC 2010 are planned on two levels: On the BORDERNETwork internal level workshops are planned on Sunday, 18th, Monday 19th and Wednesday 21st of July. These workshops are for BORDERNETwork projects, collaborating partners and sub contractors from non EU-Countries in CE and SEE Europe. The objectives of these meetings are to exchange experiences in youth prevention work and on piloting the quality assurance tool, to discuss further steps and to finalize the preparation of the lunch time seminar (dissemination level)

On the dissemination level a lunch time seminar will take place on Tuesday the 20th July in the Vienna Library. The objectives of the lunch time seminar are to give an insight into the working and cooperation strategies of BORDERNETwork, to show the need to assure quality in youth prevention activities and to present the draft version of the tool and some selected outcomes of the piloting phases in different BORDERNETwork model regions.

Discussion and Problems:

In the discussion it came very clear that most of the participants have not been able to pilot the Quiet because of short time, starting summer season and other duties and therefore it will not be possible to present results from the piloting phase during lunch time seminar. It was also obvious that not all WP 9 partner from the workshop in Vienna are also present in the start up meeting in Berlin.

Next steps:

An ad-hoc workshop was appointed to develop a revised concept for the lunch time seminar during WAC 2010.

All WP 9 participants have been informed that there is no need to present results from the pilot phase already in the Lunch time seminar in Vienna and that the pilot phase will be prolonged
